Proposed Schedule of Finishes of Blood Bank at BRGF & Non BRGF Hospitals -

- 1. All rooms will be AC except sterilization, washing and record room.
- 2. All floor, walls and ceiling should be smooth, washable, dust free and shall be capable of being kept clean.
- 3. Electrical work, plumbing work and other duct works should be concealed, flushed with the walls & ceilings. No protrusion from walls and ceilings is allowed.
- 4. Wooden furniture, wooden partition, wooden doors/windows are not allowed.
- 5. All laboratory tops, slabs, counter slabs should be of granite stone preferably of white background. Shredding, flaking and dusting materials are disallowed.
- 6. No ceiling/wall fan is allowed in the laboratories.
- 7. All doors will be of minimum 4'0" width except record room, wash room and store room.
- 9. No window is allowed in Blood Bank except sterilization, washing and record room. Exhaust fan & other fans may be provided in toilet and sterilization room.
- 10. Porcelain basin with elbow fitted taps is to be provided in Serology and TTI Unit. Porcelain Sink with elbow fitted taps is to be provided in washing unit.
- In Serology unit if a counter is required for issue of blood, counter should be of small size.
- 11. False ceiling of gypsum board with epoxy coating or false ceiling of ACP (Aluminium Composite Panel) board is suitable.
- 12. Partition wall should be made of Aluminium Channel with Clear Glass on upper side and with ACP board on lower side.
- 13. Component Section should be segregated into Processing, Storage & QC zone by about 6 ft height partition wall made of Aluminium Channel with Clear Glass on upper side and with ACP board on lower side.
- 14. The rooms should be well-lit.
- 15. Facility/Utility-wise there should be sufficient electrical points including power-points, keeping in mind for future expansions.
- 16. Blood Bank must have 24 hour Un-interrupted Power Supply.
- 17. The Blood Bank should be located at a place which shall be away from open sewage, drain, public lavatory or similar unhygienic surroundings.
- 18. The building should be constructed in such a manner so as to permit the operation of the Blood Bank under hygienic condition & shall avoid entry of insects, rodents and flies and other small animals. Drains shall be covered and shall be of adequate size and where connected directly to a sewer shall be equipped with traps to prevent backsiphon.
